The primary objective of the Northern Trust Collective S&P 500 Index Fund - DC - Lending is to approximate the risk and return characteristics of the S&P 500 Index. This Index is commonly used to represent the large cap segment of the U.S. equity market.

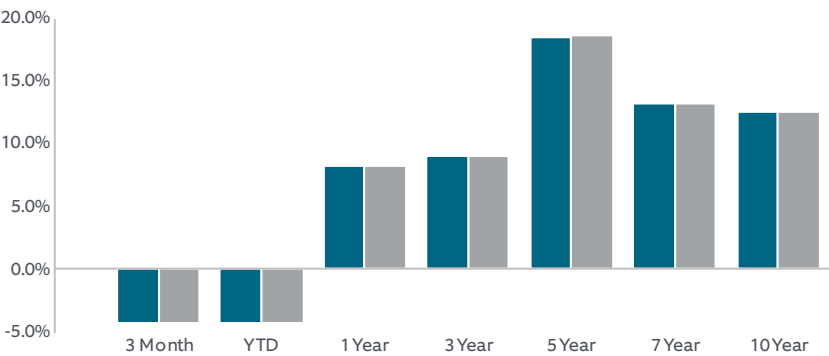
Investment Approach

To achieve its objective, the Fund employs a replication technique which generally seeks to hold each index constituent in its proportional index weight. The Fund may make limited use of futures and/or options for the purpose of maintaining equity exposure. This Fund may participate in securities lending.

DEFINITIONS

¹S&P 500 Index is an unmanaged index consisting of 500 stocks and is a widely recognized common measure of the performance of the overall U.S. stock market. It is not possible to invest directly in an index.

Tracking Error: Tracking error is a measure of the volatility of the differences in the return between a fund and its benchmark. The smaller the tracking error, the more the fund resembles the benchmark regarding risk and return characteristics.

Beta: Beta is a measure of the volatility, or systematic risk, of a security or a portfolio in comparison to the market as a whole.

Annualized Standard Deviation: Standard deviation is a measure of risk. In this case risk is represented by the fund's price movements up or down over time.
